Archery GB membership	An archery GB membership number must be declared on the entry form
Dress regulations	No frayed or camouflage clothing. No offensive language or images. Shoulders and stomach areas should be covered. Closed in shoes must be
	worn.
Shooting information	A member of Newhaven Archery Club will be acting as judge. Arrows will be shot in ends of 6. There will be 2 details per end followed by collection of arrows. There are no timings on the field, but archers who consistently take longer than 4 minutes per end will be approached. Targets do not need to be marked. Bouncers should be confirmed by other archers on your target before calling the judge.
Start times	Registration from 9.30am. Assembly 10.15am. Sighters 10.30am. Commence shooting 10.45am. Short comfort break allocated at end of 2 doz arrows. Lunch will be at distance change.
Bosses	All bosses will be straw.
Archer's special requirements	Please email the organizers <u>Newhaven_archery@yahoo.co.uk</u> if you require any special requirements such as wheelchair/stool space, arrow scorer/collector etc.
Juniors	Juniors are those archers who are 17 years old or under on the day of the competition. All juniors must be attended by a responsible adult (who may be shooting).
Handicaps	Following the introduction of the new handicap system, there will be no handicap category this year.
Prizes	1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd for seniors (18+)/juniors (8-17) in bowstyle/gender. Colour prizes Knockout tournament prize for adult/junior
Qualification for prizes	Top place winners (shooting age-appropriate distances) in each category will receive a prize. Other "on-the-spot" prizes are available for all participants.
Scores	All scores will be processed by the Newhaven Archery Club's Match Secretary and Record's Officers.
Photography	Please ensure you have signed the photography section on the entry form
Arrows	No all-carbons
Smoking	Smoking/e-cigs/vaping is only permitted at the back of the field by the cars and away from the main buildings
